

Exporting Ohio Soybeans through U.S. Pork



In 2023, pork exports accounted for
6.38 million bushels
of Ohio soybean usage



For the estimated total economic impact:
In 2023, pork exports contributed
13.86% of bushel value = \$1.95
at an average price of \$14.07 per bushel

U.S. pork exports contributed

\$113.10 per Ohio soybean acre

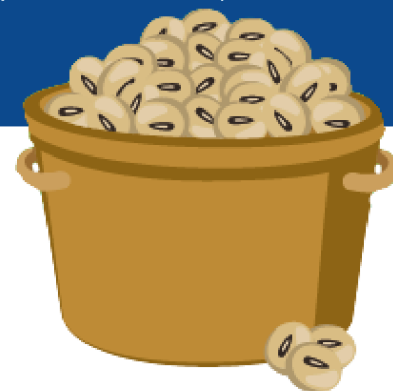
at \$1.95 per bushel at a yield of 58 bushels per acre in 2023

In 2023, the market value of pork exports to

Ohio Soybeans = \$89.73 million

(soybeans consumed by pork exports at average annual soybean price)

6.38 million bushels x \$14.07 per bushel



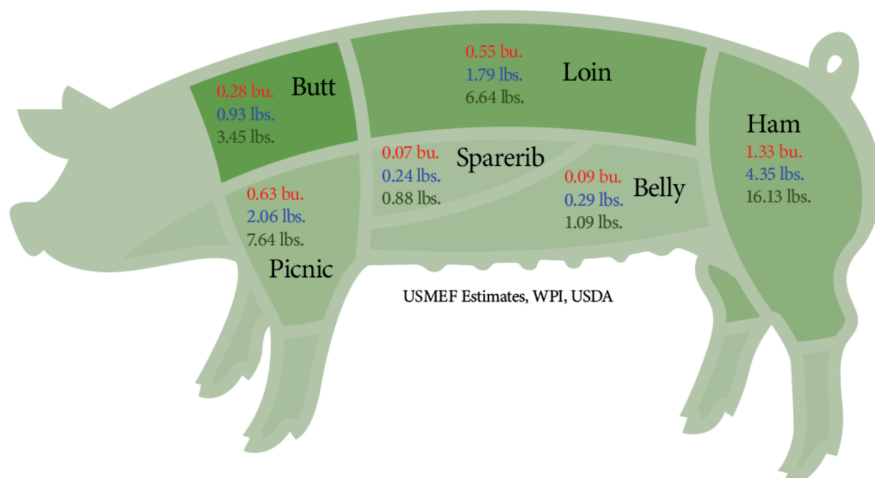
Feed Use by Cuts Exported

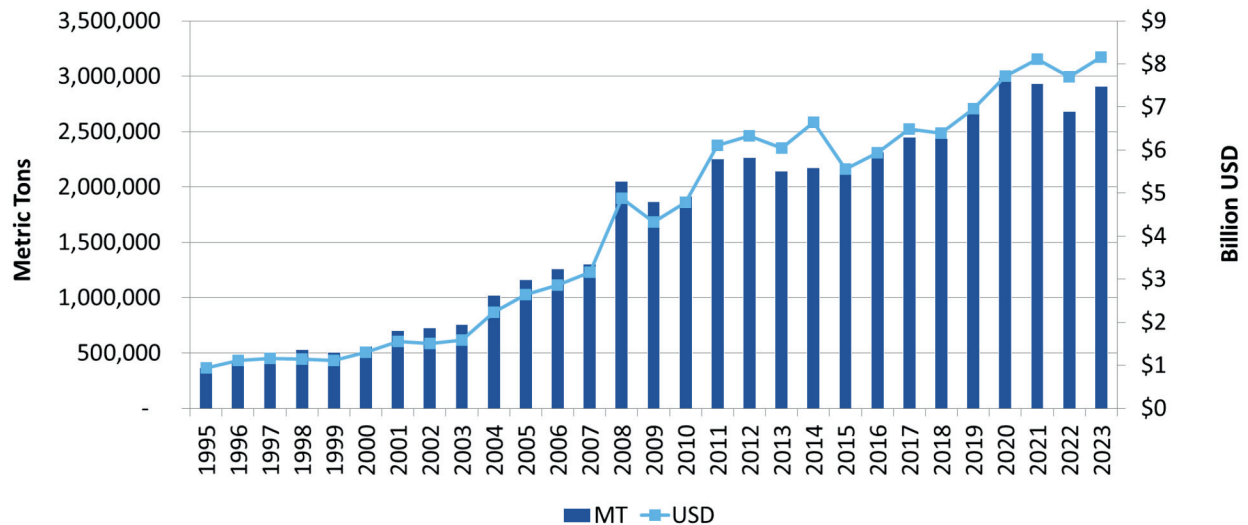
Pork export volume equated to **50 lbs. per head** slaughtered, 10.09 lbs. of which were pork variety meats (a new record)

29.6% of U.S. pork and pork variety meat production was exported, a new record

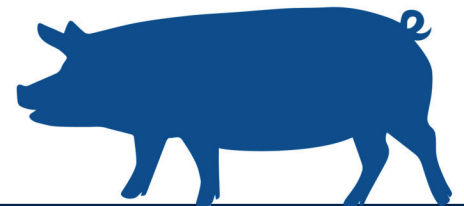
Pork production increased by 11% from 2015, while **pork exports increased by 36%** (including variety meats) during the same time

Pork export value equated to **\$64 per head** slaughtered in 2023
(export value divided by 2023 commercial hog slaughter)
